



A.K.C. Domestic Registry

Any Saluki fancier who questions the recorded parentage of a dog or litter may submit a complaint in writing to the Secretary of the Society requesting DNA testing and a Critique Judge compliance investigation. The complaint must be accompanied by a deposit of \$1000.00. If the allegation is sustained the deposit is returned. If the allegation is not sustained, the deposit is forfeited and becomes the property of The Society for the Perpetuation of Desert Bred Salukis.

Complaints on Generation 3 AKC registered Saluki must first go through the AKC and its Complaint process.

In cases where parentage is shown to be incorrect, or proper Critique procedures were not followed, The Society will work with the Breeders and Owners to correct the registrations of dogs and litters when possible. The responsible Breeders will be billed for any additional DNA processing costs and registration correction fees. Registration services will be placed on hold until payment is made. When corrections cannot be made, the necessary registrations may be converted to Generation 0 status or removed at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
